Program Notes

Beep Beep! was composed to provide a bit of light-hearted musical fun for both your band and audience to enjoy! The insistent ‘beeping’ of the clarinets and alto saxophones interrupts and complements a joyful opening melody, which in turn leads to a contrasting section featuring just a hint of ragtime rhythm, all of which is set over a relaxed and swinging groove. A sprinkling of humorous ‘Vaudeville’ effects in the percussion adds to the fun.

Rehearsal suggestions

Beep Beep! should be performed in an easy, relaxed swing style. Encourage your percussionists to play eighth notes in the ride cymbal and snare drum parts with an authentic swing feel. In addition, be sure to have your wind players emphasize beats two and four throughout, especially where marked with accents, to build the groove and push the tune forward.

In general, have your band pay careful attention to slurs, and exaggerate all dynamics and dynamic changes to help make the music come alive. Keep the bass line as light as possible, with quarter notes played full-value except where indicated otherwise. The clarinet and saxophone ‘beeps’ should be resonant and not too short. The bike horn, although optional, adds a nice touch!

Wire brushes are preferred for the snare drum beginning at m. 33. If brushes are unavailable, playing on the rim of the snare drum with sticks will work as a substitute.

I hope that you and your band will enjoy rehearsing and performing **Beep Beep!** as much as I enjoyed writing it!

Steve Frank, recently retired from the West Genesee Central School District, Camillus, New York, has enjoyed a long career in music education, with over thirty-five years of experience as a band and jazz band director at the elementary, middle, high school, and community college levels. Steve is currently a member of the adjunct faculty at the Setnor School of Music, Syracuse University, Syracuse, N.Y., where he serves as both a course instructor in the music education department as well as a field evaluator of student teachers.

Steve maintains an active schedule as guest conductor, clinician, adjudicator, and trombonist. As a free-lance professional trombonist, Steve has performed and recorded with groups as diverse as the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra, the Detroit Concert Band, under the direction of Leonard B. Smith, the rock band La La Land, and a multitude of jazz and big bands. Steve brings this wealth of experience to his writing, with compositions for elementary concert band and for trombone, and trombone ensemble, among his many published works. “The Good Book, Vols. I & II,” his series of supplemental exercises for winds, has been used for years by band directors in across New York State. Steve’s composition “Variations on Barnacle Bill, the Sailor” has been performed and recorded by trombonists around the world, including Charlie Vernon, bass trombonist of the Chicago Symphony.
