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HEADIN' DOWN TO LUCIE-TOWN

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

- 1) This is a joyful tune in an easy Reggae feel based on a familiar chord progression. The eighth notes should be played in a triplet shuffle feel with jazz phrasing. If you wish, the melody at Letter A may be played by a Solo Trumpet or Flute.
- 2) The drums play a "one drop rhythm" which places the bass drum and cross-stick back-beat on the 3rd quarter note of the measure. Feel free to play around with the closed hi-hat pattern. The drum solo at Letter L may be opened up by repeating the two bars as marked. Cue the band at measure 97 to continue.
- 3) The chords in this piece are mainly triads and minor seventh chords - there are no dominant seventh chords. The Piano and Guitar parts should play simple voicings like those written. The rhythm section may improvise on the accompaniment patterns but should remember that it is important to maintain the Reggae groove indicated.
- 4) There are solos for Bass, Alto Sax, Trumpet and Piano which may be played ad lib or as written. The canonic section which begins at Letter I should build to the Drum solo that follows.
- 5) Be sure to insist that your students play the articulations and dynamic markings properly. This will give life and expression to the arrangement.
- 6) Learning time is always hastened when students can hear the recorded example which can be found on Smart Chart Music (smartchartmusic.com) or C.L. Barnhouse (barnhouse.com) websites
